A true disciple is a follower of his or her master.




His or her characters are as follows;

 ✓ Love of the word – They hear the word, read it, internalize and heed it.

✓ Commit to Christ - When the disciples heard what John had said, they immediately followed Jesus. These men had heard John tell that One was coming after him who was mightier than he. He even identified Him as the Son of God. It was no surprise then that when the disciples saw Jesus walk by they left John and followed after Jesus.

✓ Jesus called other disciples; they would leave everything and follow after Him completely.



A true disciple is not just involved but is committed to take up his own cross and follow Jesus to the very end. That is a complete and lasting commit ment.

A longing to know Christ –

When Jesus turned and saw the men following Him, He asked them what they were seeking. Why did Jesus ask that question? Did He not know what they

were seeking? Jesus did not ask questions for information because He is omniscient. He asked the question for the disciples to identify their desire.

The work of evangelism is never complete until the evangelized become the evangelizer. Andrew is identified as one of the two disciples. Notice what he did immediately. He found his own brother, told him about Jesus and then brought him to Jesus. A true disciple will bring others to Jesus.

#### Barriers to discipleship

- Maturity If the church leaders are spiritually immature, how do we ever expect the congregation to become mature? The church may have great people, but have you led them to be more than what they are/ If we don't inspire them or equip them or challenge them to do more than the bare minimum, why should we be shocked by the level of spiritual depth represented in our congregation? We should sharpen them (Prov 27:17) to do their absolute best.
- Authority If Scripture isn't your source of authority, Christian discipleship cannot take place. Our sole source of authority and driving basis for all our decisions should be the word of God. While many churches will claim to have it as their authority, many don't communicate why people personally in the Word is important for their lives (Joshua 1:8).
- Accountability For this to take place, each member should be a part of a group or has someone who provokes them to love and good deeds and is willing to accept responsibility towards them( Heb 10; 24 – 25). Leadership should show accountability by



Leadership should show accountability by helping new people to navigate the process of getting connected, and relationships within the church should provide accountability towards growth.

Reproducibility – If the process isn't reproducible, it is not biblical discipleship. (2 Tim. 2:2)

can't be a copy and paste approach. People are different. A realization that a one size

doesn't fit all in regards to disciple making is critical. Each church me should be receiving some individual focus, attention, and care in regards to growing stronger in their Christian life.

### **CONFERENCE DAY TWO**

Highlights;

• *I need to get my life right first syndrome* -Waiting for your life to be right first is when you make disciple will delay this process. This is because your life is never going to be completely right. Becoming a fully mature disciple of Christ is a process; a process that takes a life time so get out and witness!

- *I am a sinner just saved by grace, what right do I have to speak into other person's life.* We do agree you are saved by grace by Jesus has commanded you to go make disciples. You are an ambassador of Christ.
- *Fear* One fear you might have is that you won't know what to say. While that is a real fear, we don't have to let it keep us from making disciples. Jesus hasn't left us alone. "And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."" (Mt 28:20b)

God uses disciples to make disciples. So if we don't do it, no one else is going to do it. We are the God's plan!

## **CONFERENCE DAY THREE**
